He said that a well control incident has caused a release of Oil to the Gulf of Mexico... this is 48 miles off shore... He said that there are some unaccounted for personnel ... There are injuries, however he could not state how many at this time... The oil sheen is 2 miles long by 1/2 mile wide , it is 50% coverage, with 15 % being dark, 20 % dull, 35% Brightly colored , and 30 % silver... The sheen is in two section... The information of the sheen is for the northern most part... They do not anticipate any shoreline impact at this time... NRC REPORT # 937721... They are working with the MMS and Coast guard for response actions...
