

**Resolution of the Region-wide Trustee Implementation Group Regarding the Process for
Rotation of the Primary and Alternate Points of Contact**


The undersigned representatives of the Region-wide Trustee Implementation Group (TIG) hereby create and approve the process for the rotation of the primary point of contact (POC) and an alternate POC for the Region-wide TIG, as set forth below:

1. Under section 2.4.1 of the Trustee Council Standard Operating Procedures for Implementation of Natural Resource Restoration for the *Deepwater Horizon* Oil Spill (SOPs) (revised November 15, 2016), “[a] primary point of contact (POC) will be designated within each TIG. The TIG primary POC will coordinate with the Trustee Council and the LAT to encourage consistency of TIG operations with these SOPs, including timely project reporting and submission of documents to the Administrative Record. Each TIG will notify the current Trustee Council Chair of its designated POC.”
2. Beginning January 1 of each calendar year, the Region-wide TIG primary POC position will rotate between the federal and state Trustees.
3. Beginning January 1 of each calendar year, the Region-wide TIG alternate POC position will rotate between the federal and state Trustees.
4. The alternate POC will assume the role of primary POC at the beginning of each new calendar year.
5. Prior to the beginning of each calendar year in which a state Trustee is to be the new alternate POC, the state Trustees will decide which state will serve in that position.
6. Prior to the beginning of each calendar year in which a federal Trustee is to be the new alternate POC, the federal Trustees will decide which federal Trustee will serve in that position.
7. Effective January 1, 2017, Mississippi is the primary POC for the Region-wide TIG.
8. Effective January 1, 2017, EPA is the alternate POC for the Region-wide TIG.






